## Introduction to NAYD

National Alliance on Youth Development NAYD is a National level alliance of more 100 youth-led, youth supported, youth focused organizations and Youth Volunteer groups/Associations. It is the platform of integration, complementing and consolidation for youth related organizations across the country. NAYD is formed to foster the divided efforts of Local, National and International organizations working on youth Development and to build-up pressure on government to develop and implement youth policies on regular basis. The main purpose of this alliance is to strengthen the linkages and networking of member organizations at national and global level to reduce uncertainty and isolation among them to actively contribute for youth development program. Further, NAYD has Chapters to oversight the government initiated interventions (Projects/Programs) in their respective provinces and states

NAYD is the platform to create fathom and trust through increased interaction among member organizations. It is also focusing to divert their concentration on the issues faced by youth at local, provincial and national level. In this context, the productive and substantial actions and interventions of member organizations are consolidated and highlighted to encourage them for achievement of the set goals of youth Development Program. Further, the alliance is playing significant role in developing strong coordination within members and connecting them with international agencies working for youth development.

- To promote strategic alliances and partnerships with public and private sector organizations to incorporate and support Youth Service programs.

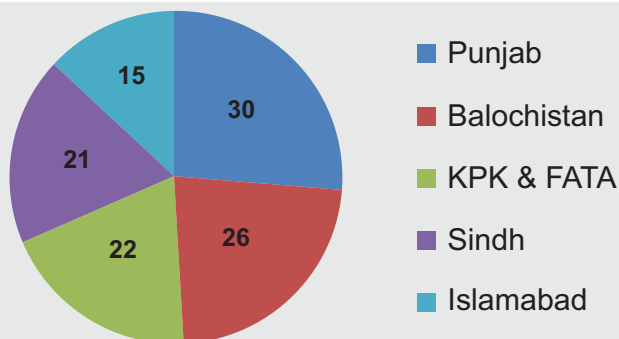

## National and Provincial Representation in NAYD

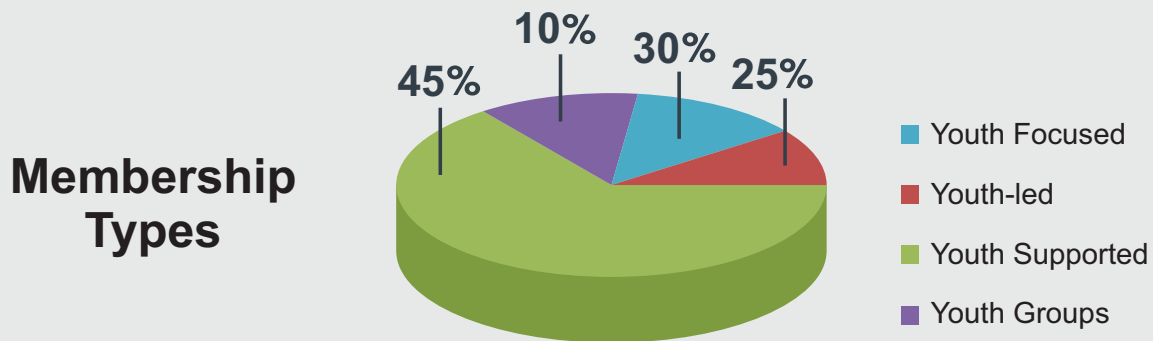
NAYD has representation of organizations from all four provinces and Capital of Pakistan. Approximately, 114 organizations are the member of this Network as 30 from Punjab, 26 from Baluchistan, 22 from KPK& Fata, 21 from Sindh and 15 national and international organizations from Islamabad. Further, NAYD secretariat is in coordination and communication with organizations of FATA, Gilgit Baltistan and AJK for increasing the NAYD membership in these states. The bellow mentioned graph delineates provincial segregation of the NAYD members.

## Types of Organization NAYD Members

NAYD members are divided into four types as youth focused, Youth-led, Youth Supported organizations and non registered volunteer Youth Groups or Associations. Further, there is also representation of International organizations (that directly address the Youth Component) in different chapters of NAYD. Following graph gives the apparent looks on types of organizations have NAYD membership.



## NAYD Membership Process

NAYD membership is awarded to only those organizations who agreed on the basis of NAYD TORs. For instances, applications for membership are reviewed and organizational capacity assessment is carried out by the Membership Approval Committee (MAP) which is based on members from provincial Chapters / National Council. After following the entire process, NAYD Committee approves the membership of organizations. The organizations are asked to submit the required documents as listed below and membership is awarded on the basis of submission of enlisted documents. Following documents are pre-requisite for membership in NAYD.

- Registration certificate
- Last audit report
- Filled application form
- Annual/ Progress Report.
- List of Board of Directors
- Application from concern NGO
- Annual fee submission by applicant
- MoU with NAYD by applicant/
- Associate Members group must be consisted of at least 15 members.
- Associate members should fill application forms and provide CNIC and List of Members.

## NAYD Structure

National Alliance on Youth Development has comprehensible structure. It relies on National level Council and Provincial Chapters along with Secretariat. NAYD National Council is comprised upon 31 Members (05 from each province/ region and 01 (founder organization). The 30 members are elected by Provincial Chapters through democratic approach as holding elections among members to elect the 05 members (02 youth focused, 02 youth-led, 01 youth supported) for National Council. The Executive Body has seven members including 3 office bearers, which will lead the National Council and Provincial Chapters.

There are five chapters (Punjab, KPK & FATA, Sindh, Baluchistan and Islamabad) in NAYD. Each Chapter has Executive Body, NC Members and General Body. The provincial Chapters have 07 members for Executive Body and 05 Members for National Council and 3 would be office bearers General Body members. The Executive Body members are the leading members of their respective chapters. Similarly, the NC members will represent their province at national level.



## NAYD Secretariat

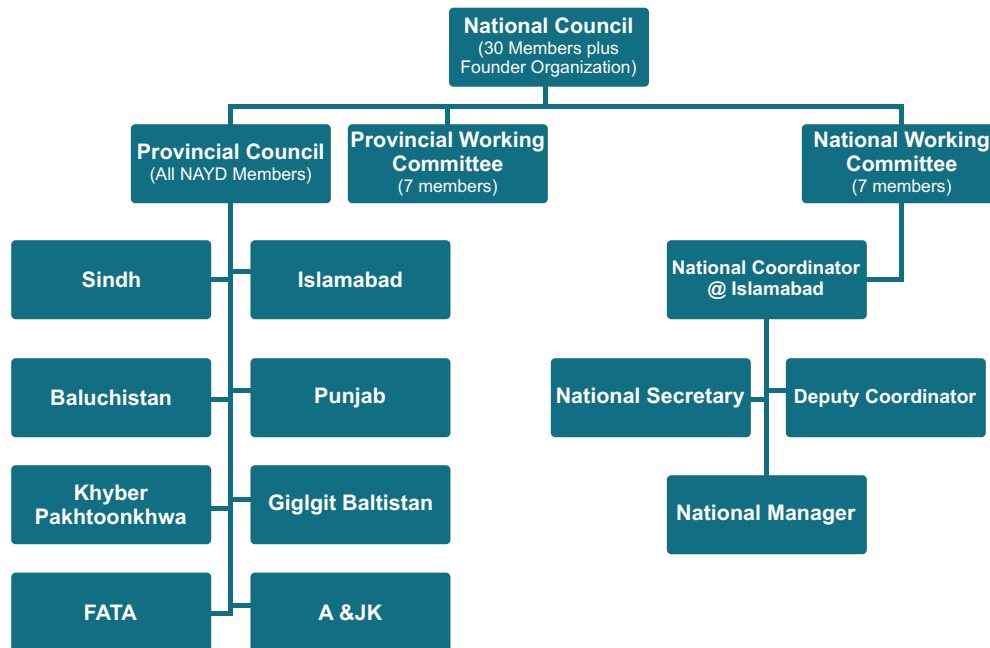
NAYD Secretariat is based in Capital City of Pakistan Islamabad. Senior Program Officer of CSSP is responsible for coordination and communication with NAYD members. The secretariat is facilitating members in holding meetings and planning to lead the agenda of youth development. Currently CSSP is bearing the expensive of Secretary.

## Roles & Responsibilities of NAYD Secretariat

NAYD Secretariat is facilitating the valued members through sharing information on funding opportunities, training workshops/events for youth, Fellowships, Scholarships, Research Studies, Consultancy firms providing technical support to local organizations through email circulation on yahogroup.com. The member CSOs are also provided space in monthly newsletter published by Secretariat Islamabad. The table below shows roles & responsibilities of NAYD Secretariat:
